Program

The Center for Prevention and Counseling would like to welcome you to our Intensive Outpatient Family Group. We consider this group to be a unique experience for those who attend. You will find this group, which is open only to family members of those in treatment, to be a combination of education and support. This family, educational and support group is led by a certified drug and alcohol counselor (CADC), under the supervision of a licensed alcohol and drug counselor (LCADC).
As a result of the use of experimental and didactic approaches, participants are taught new skills for healthier living, enhancing the family dynamics. This approach, along with the expertise and dedication of the facilitators, helps to make this group special, and will enable families to trust, laugh, and love again.

Trust and Confidentiality

The most important reason this group works so well is that we have developed a strong sense of trust through respect for confidentiality. It is important, not only for the other members of the group, but also for you to feel the comfort and respect that comes with trust. Of course, we cannot guarantee confidentiality, but if we can all work together toward this goal, our group will remain a safe place for all of us. We ask that you agree to respect the confidentiality and anonymity of each fellow member.
